

Hello everyone!

I wanted to give you an update of where I am in preparation of my upcoming move to Guatemala. I have received a lot of one-time donations and I have had some people who have partnered with me in monthly support. As of right now, I do have more than the first month of costs covered, and I am so blessed and grateful for that. To anyone who has prayed for me, given a one-time donation, or signed up to give monthly, thank you so much! It means so much to me to have so many friends and family support me and partner with me in furthering God's work in the lives of the children at Casa De Mi Padre.

My goal before I leave is to have 70% of the monthly support that I will need to live in Guatemala. With the supporters that I have currently, I am a little over 20%. I am still looking and praying for people to partner with me in monthly support. This has been something that has weighed on my mind, but I know that God is sovereign, and He will work everything according to His will.

Proverbs 14:15 says, "The simple believes everything, but the prudent gives thought to his steps." Although I am not fully funded yet, I know that God has called me to go to Guatemala. I am giving thought to each of my steps and readying myself to go and one of the biggest steps was the purchase of my plane ticket! I will be flying out on Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup> and will hopefully arrive at Casa De Mi Padre that same night. This gives me about 70 days to get prepared and ready to leave. I have started writing my "to-do" list with everything that needs to get done before I leave (even as I am writing this, I have added about 7 new things to my list).

Some things that were on my list were classes and certifications to help me be as useful as I can when I start working with the children. I am now First Aid/AED/CPR certified for Pediatrics and Adults, I also took a short online course on the basics and outlines of teaching ESL (English as a Second Language), at the end of this month I will be taking two Self Defense courses, and I applied for an IADP (Inter-American Driver's Permit) so I can drive when I am down there.

As I continue to prepare for June 4<sup>th</sup>, would you please pray for me? Please pray that:

- God will provide the necessary 70% of monthly support
- I will continue to check things off of my to-do list to be ready by June
- I will continue to trust in God's sovereignty and not be overwhelmed
- For me as I will start saying good-bye to family & friends in the next couple of months
