

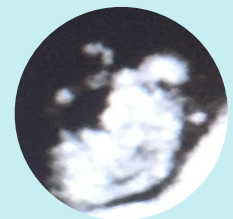


Cole and Sarah McCauley, missionaries in Guatemala

I want you to know Jesus Christ, and I want you to take good care of the children you have now. After the court hearing had ended, Sandra and I talk more in-depth with her step father about the grace of God and what it looks like to follow Christ. He said that he felt terrible for his past and wanted to live differently going forward. I expressed a little of my past and declared my thankfulness for God's grace.

Sandra had been in our home for almost seven years, but is now transitioning. I remember how shy Sandra was when I first came to Casa de mi Padre. She was quiet but very sweet. Sandra has become just like a daughter to me, and she loves Sarah dearly also. She will be forever like a

daughter; she calls me father, and I would do anything for her.

Seeing her grow up has been such a blessing to my soul. We are so proud of the young woman she is becoming, and to personally see this testimony myself and share it with the others who have invested in her, we are extremely proud of her. Beyond the spiritual growth and maturity in her life, she is doing well transitioning out of our home. We miss her, but Sandra is doing well with family of a former pastor of ours. She is weekly going to school and studying technical drawing along with actively being a part of her church and a youth group in the church. A big thanks to all of you who were praying for our transitional kids. All of them have a Guatemalan family to live with now and seem to be doing well. **Please be praying that all the children at our home would truly understand their need for Jesus Christ, that it would influence the way they live, and that God would give them hearts to share it also!**

God blessed our recent support raising trip to the USA with many opportunities to share the inspiring testimonies of the changed lives of the kids at Casa.
